Tashkent pediatric medical institute (TashPMI)

I. General provisions

1. The Institute of Pediatrics of Central Asia was established in 1972 by the decision of the USSR Council of Ministers on July 23, 1971. In accordance with Order No. 226 of 22 March 1988, the Ministry of health of the Uzbek SSR was renamed into the Tashkent pediatric medical institute (TashPMI). TashPMI is a part of Academy of Sciences of Uzbekistan

2. TashPMI is the state higher educational institution performing educational actions for introduction of basic and additional programs of professional education of the higher education, and also educational and pedagogical, scientific and methodical and other activity according to the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan and provides educational services.

3. TashPMI carries out its activities in accordance with the Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the law "on education", the national program for training, resolutions of the Oliy Majlis, the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, decrees, resolutions and orders, resolutions and orders of the Cabinet of Ministers, the Ministry of higher and secondary special education of the normative legal act of this Charter.

4. TashPMI is a legal entity. Has a special property in the operational management and is responsible for their property in accordance with its obligations, may acquire property on his behalf, to take responsibility and be brought to justice. It has a Bank account and other accounts, including accounts in foreign currency, stamp with stamps and other requisites of the state emblem of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

II. Main objectives of the Tashkent pediatric medical institute

5. The main objectives of the Tashkent pediatric medical institute are:

- meeting the needs of the individual in intellectual, cultural and spiritual and moral development through the acquisition of higher education and postgraduate education;
- to develop a fully advanced and loyal person, a citizen of an independent state, a selfless nation of society and family, respecting national and universal values, enriching and strengthening national traditions, honest and decent work for the future of our Motherland;
- development of science through research and creative activity of scientific and pedagogical staff and students, the use of the results in the educational process;
- training, retraining and advanced training of specialists with higher education in the relevant fields of Economics and scientific and pedagogical personnel;
- preservation and enrichment of the moral, cultural and scientific value of society;
- dissemination of knowledge among the population, raising its spiritual, educational and cultural level.

III. Subjects of educational and scientific-methodical work of their rights and obligations

(a) Students:

6. A person enrolled at the direction of the rector of the Institute is a student of TashPMI. Students are provided with a student ID card and a rating book. According to the statements of the persons having General secondary, secondary special, professional education in TashPMI in the manner prescribed by law, the rating scoring system established by the state Commission on acceptance in educational institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan in accordance with the procedure and rules of admission to higher educational institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan in accordance with the test results, the Admission to higher education institutions based on equal rights for all (as grants and contractual) on the basis of common making rules, and based on one choice, ensuring the right of candidates of the first degree to receive state grants, which have the highest scores on the results of tests. All other applicants have the right to apply for a quota based on a rating-based contract. According to the law, acceptance on the basis of certain preferences without testing is guaranteed.

7. The rights of students TashPMI:

- Acquisition of knowledge related to science, technology and modern technologies;

- free use of books, periodicals, e - learning institutions, available at the information center of higher education;
- Get free advice and guidance;
- free use of classrooms, objects of educational process;
- submit their proposals and criticisms to the educational institution, Dean's office and Department management in accordance with the established procedure on the effectiveness of the educational process and the quality of education and require their consideration;
- participation in mass events held at the University and the faculty;
- participation in research and scientific conferences and publication and reporting of their results;
- to participate in public associations in higher education institutions.

The student has the right to receive high-quality and higher education and to exercise other rights that do not contradict the legislation necessary for the qualification of a specialist. A student should not abuse his / her rights or use them for purposes contrary to the interests of others.

8. Students studying in the form of state and paid education receive scholarships provided by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan. Students have the right to apply for scholarships of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, state scholarships of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan and state scholarships of Beruni, Ibn Sina, Navoi and Ulugbek.

9. During the period of military service, rehabilitation, pregnancy and childbirth, as well as maternity leave for child care, the student can get an academic leave from the Ministry of higher and secondary special education of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

10. In accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan, students are allowed to postpone the period of admission to military service during their stay in a higher educational institution.

11. Students in need of a hostel will be provided with accommodation in accordance with sanitary norms and rules of students of TashPMI. Student housing is determined by the higher education institution taking into account payments for utilities. It is not allowed to use the student dormitory for other purposes (rent, other contracts). Students who study off-the-job are allowed to work in higher education institutions, as well as in other places in their spare time.

12. Student of Tashkent pediatric medical institute, which was dismissed at his own request or on other grounds is entitled to recovery to the Institute.

In the past, students expelled at the initiative of the administration of higher education institutions restored on a contractual basis. TashPMI students have the right to transfers for the purpose of education, to other higher education institutions. Educational activities for students of TashPMI are prohibited in the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan for unlicensed private institutions of higher education and branches of higher educational institutions in other countries (centers, departments,

educational consulting centers, etc.) the rules of education, translation, expulsion are established by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

13. Provided for in the curriculum of educational programs the students of higher educational institutions accept the knowledge required to perform all types of tasks during the period specified in the Charter of the Tashkent pediatric medical institute's internal rules students must follow these rules. With the exception of cases stipulated by the Government of the Republic of Uzbekistan, at the expense of time not associated with the process of education.

14. Disciplinary sanctions applied to the student in case of violation of the provisions of the Charter and internal regulations of institutions of higher education by reprimand or expulsion of the student.

A student may be expelled from a higher education institution for the following reasons:

- a) at will;
- b) transfer of education to another educational institution;
- c) because of the reasons of health (on the basis of the reference to the medical Commission);
- d) for academic failure (debt);
- e) for violation of academic discipline and internal procedures of higher educational institution;
- f) for skipping over 74 hours without the release of the learning process during one semester;
- g) due to the lack of timely payment for the educational process (for those who are students on the basis of a contract);
- h) because of a prison sentence imposed by a court;
- i) as a result of death.

Exemption from the process of teaching students at the initiative of the University administration is based on the written consent of the Union (for students who are members of the Union). The student may also agree with the basic organization of the public youth movement "Kamolot" in accordance with paragraph 14 (D) of this regulation. Disciplinary punishment may be appealed against the legality and fairness of the sanctions imposed on it in the manner prescribed by law. Information about disciplinary action with the student is stored in his / her personal folder. Disciplinary sanctions shall be imposed not later than six months after the date of the Commission of the act and not less than six months after the Commission of the act without taking into account the time of illness or leave. Students may not be expelled during sickness, on holiday with an academic holiday, or during pregnancy and childbirth. When the illness is over, the student (or his / her parents) will be informed of the attendance with relevant documentation, usually at least a week later.

15. Students who successfully study in TashPMI but separated or dismissed from the place of work, receive benefits provided by the relevant articles of the

Labour code of the Republic of Uzbekistan (additional leave without pay or unpaid leave, travel allowance to a higher educational institution and back).

b) Students:

16. Students are those who study at the center for retraining in the framework of TashPMI. The status of trainees is equivalent to the status of a student at the tertiary level in the field of educational services in the form of appropriate education. Procedures for retraining and retraining of personnel, terms and conditions of training of students are determined by the relevant legal acts in accordance with the legislation.

c) research Interns, senior researchers:

17. Trainee-researcher of Tashkent pediatric medical institute is a senior researcher who is engaged in scientific research in a certain direction and prepares a thesis for the relevant degree. Intern researcher-a person who has a higher education and a master's degree, who studies at a higher educational institution and conducts research to obtain a degree of doctor of philosophy. Senior researchers-researchers - those who have a PhD and enrolled in the senior scientific staff of the Institute, conducting research to obtain a doctoral degree. An independent researcher is attached to the higher educational institution (Department) and prepares a thesis for the degree of doctor of philosophy or doctor of philosophy.

18. Persons who have demonstrated the ability to conduct research with a diploma of higher qualification and a master's degree in the international research Institute of TashPMI are accepted for a three-year term. Training at the Higher Research Institute is conducted separately from production. You must also demonstrate the knowledge gained in a bachelor's degree to a master's degree. Highly qualified scientific and scientific-pedagogical staff with academic degrees of candidate of Sciences, can become a doctoral thesis for a doctoral thesis at the TashPMI, has made significant scientific achievements, capable to solve research problems at the highest level and have important socio-economic importance. Training at the Institute of senior research interns is two or three years, depending on the direction of the specialty. Training of highly qualified scientific and pedagogical personnel can be carried out in the direction of an independent researcher, with the exception of researchers-interns, assistants and researchers. To obtain a doctorate degree, having obtained a master's degree prior to receiving academic degrees and having a minimum of one-year internship in science and medicine and having sufficient knowledge of the chosen specialty can participate. Candidates who have profound knowledge of their doctoral theses and have achieved significant results in scientific research on topical issues of medicine and theoretical issues and who have profound knowledge in their specialties are eligible for a degree.

d) Structure of the teaching staff of higher educational institution, the educational and administrative personnel (personnel)

19. In TashPMI work professors, teachers, engineers, technicians, administrative and economic, industrial, educational assistants and other employees. Professors and teachers include head of the Department, Professor, associate Professor, senior lecturer, teacher, assistant and trainee (teacher-trainee of the Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Uzbekistan, August 1, 2008, № 164 "on approval of improved payment system for employees of higher educational institutions of the Republic", the Republic of Uzbekistan).

20. The teaching staff is engaged on a competitive basis in accordance with the Regulations on the procedure for recruiting teachers to higher education institutions approved by the Cabinet of Ministers on 16 February 2006. In accordance with the decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan of 9 March 1992, F-137, the Vice-rector of the higher education institution is appointed head of the Ministry of health on the recommendation of the rector in coordination with the Office of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan. Dean of the faculty is appointed by the order of the rector of the educational institution in coordination with the Ministry of health.

21. The teaching staff of Tashkent pediatric medical institute has the following rights:

- in accordance with the established procedure to be elected to the scientific Council and scientific communities;
- to participate in the discussion of issues related to the activities of higher education institutions;
- use of the information resource center of the higher educational institution, educational and scientific divisions, and also services of social, house, medical and other departments according to the collective agreement;
- selection of methods and means of education, research, ensuring high quality of the educational and scientific process;
- apply in the order established by the legislation, orders and orders of administration of the higher educational institution;
- take part in competitions and hold positions in the manner prescribed by law;
- work in the Department, except for faculties, other faculties, departments, organizations (in agreement with the main place of work);
- get acquainted and share scientific and educational literature with foreign colleagues;
- preparation of quality textbooks and manuals on the subject;
- improvement of theoretical knowledge about practical experience, methods of scientific research, pedagogical skills;
- guide students to research;
- participation in grants, research projects, economic contracts;
- use of other rights provided for by the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan on education.

22. Responsibilities of teaching staff of Tashkent pediatric medical institute:

- strict observance of the legislation on education, labor and technological discipline, the Statute of the institution, the rules of internal labor; conscientious performance of its duties and respect for the title-teacher;

- Communication with staff, students and others who communicate in the workplace;

- to carry out legal instructions of the employer, timely and qualitatively to carry out educational and methodical, scientific and spiritual and educational work on the basis of the personal plan approved annually, in particular:

- a) the volume of educational materials, educational and methodical, scientific and educational and organizational work on the basis of individual plans and participation in spiritual and educational work;

- b) preparation of textbooks, manuals, educational abbreviations, scientific articles, monographs;

- C) participation in educational work, direct involvement in spiritual and educational work with students, including in extra-curricular activities;

- d) participation in scientific topics of the Department approved by the scientific Council;

- d) a regular increase your own skills;

- compliance with safety and health regulations;

- maintenance and rational use of the property of the enterprise;

- compensation of actual material damage directly to the employer;

- participation in public Affairs;

- ensuring the effectiveness of the pedagogical and scientific process; - education in modern civilization and democracy in accordance with the direction (specialty) recipients of high professional training;

- improving the literacy of foreign languages and information technologies;

- formation of independent thinking, initiative, creative abilities of students;

- participation in the system " teacher-pupil " and carrying out scientific, spiritual and educational work with their students;

- to be an example of his moral, cultural and spiritual level;

- to comply with the culture difficulties;

- know about current reforms and innovations in the world;

- active participation in cultural, spiritual and educational activities organized by the faculty;

- enrichment of the curriculum on science on the basis of regular achievements of science and technology;

- passing lessons at a high level;

- find new sources of science and acquaint them with students;

- before the beginning of each academic year to approve at the meeting of the Department work program, schedule and rating of science, develop control schedules;

- timely implementation of rating measures;

- impartial assessment of students ' knowledge;
- application of new pedagogical technologies in the classroom;
- improvement of scientific potential and pedagogical skills;
- to lead the work carried out by research students;
- active participation in reforms of higher education systems;

23. Foreign trips of the teaching staff are carried out according to the order of the Ministry of foreign Affairs of 13.04.05, № 81 "on the procedure of travel abroad from higher educational institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan".

24. The teaching staff of Tashkent pediatric medical institute is obliged to increase the qualification at least once in three years.

25. The rights and obligations of the administrative-economic, engineering, educational assistant, and other staff of Tashkent pediatric medical institute are determined by internal rules of higher educational institutions and job descriptions.

27. TashPMI implements the basic educational program in two stages: a bachelor's degree and master's degree.

Bachelor's degree-basic higher education, which provides fundamental and applied education in the direction of education, which will last 7 years. Graduates of the undergraduate program are awarded a bachelor's degree in education based on the results of the state certification and a state diploma.

Master's degree - higher education, which provides basic and practical knowledge in a particular specialty with the minimum length of studies is 2 years. Graduates of the master's program are awarded a master's degree in the specialty prepared by the state certification, and the state diploma is issued. Bachelor's and master's degree gives you the opportunity to continue your studies at the next stages of your education in accordance with the chosen direction and specialty. Primary education in basic education programmes at different stages of higher education is not considered a second higher education.

28. The organization of educational process in TashPMI is regulated by the curriculum and the curriculum developed and approved by the basic higher educational institution, the schedule of the annual calendar and schedule of events approved by the rector of the higher educational institution (Vice-rector for academic Affairs). Having established the educational process by selecting the forms, methods and tools of the educational process, students of higher educational institutions should be provided with the necessary conditions for mastering the basic professional educational programs of higher education. The unity of the educational process is ensured by state educational standards. Vice-rector for spiritual and moral education is responsible for coordinating the activities of the departments of socio-economic and human Sciences, spiritual education and sports, students and other public organizations of higher education.

29. In TashPMI the following types of training are conducted: lecture, consultation, seminar, practical work, laboratory work, independent work, written work, practice, course work (course work) and master's work. The minimum academic time of 45 (or 40 minutes without interruption) is set for all classroom

classes. Breaks between classes are at least 10 minutes, lunch breaks - 40 minutes. Languages of teaching and educational process - Uzbek and Russian.

30. Training of specialists in TashPMI is carried out separately from the educational process. The state educational standard used by the state Agency "Uzstandard" is used for all forms of education within the framework of the main program of professional higher education.

31. The academic year at the Tashkent pediatric medical institute is divided into two semesters, and each of them is provided in the form of rating control. Transfer of students from course to course is carried out by order of the rector on the recommendation of the Dean of the faculty. Students cannot be transferred without proper supervision. Development of educational programs of higher professional education, approved by the Ministry of higher and secondary special education and state registration in the Ministry of justice, "the control of knowledge of students of higher educational institutions and governed in accordance with the" regulations on the rating system of evaluation, the final state certification of graduates of higher educational institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan " final certification of graduates in accordance with the "regulations "

32. TashPMI conducts methodological work aimed at improving the quality of training through advanced pedagogical and information technologies, individualization of education and self-learning tools, modular system and distance learning.

In accordance with the decree Of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan № PP-1426 of November 2, 2010 "on further improvement of the system of training of highly qualified scientific and pedagogical personnel" was resumed postgraduate education at TashPMI, and the period of training of interns-3 years; system of senior researchers - researchers is introduced within 2-3 years, depending on the direction of research.

34. TashPMI is included in the resolution of the Cabinet Of Ministers of February 16, 2006 № 25 "on further improvement of the system of retraining and advanced training of teachers" on the basis of the needs of personnel of the public health system in the Republic of Uzbekistan

35. TashPMI conducts research and creative work, attracts students, postgraduates and doctoral students on the thematic plans of the academic Council, the quality of work and safety. Research is funded from the following sources: - state budget funds allocated for implementation of fundamental, applied and innovative research in key areas of science, technology and culture; - line ministries, agencies, enterprises, associations and others on a contract basis, including funds from foreign organizations.

There are 2 academic lyceums in the field of chemistry and biology in TashPMI. YUNUSABAD academic Lyceum, founded in 1997, TashPMI no. 2 secondary vocational schools of December 21, 2006, by order № 202 transferred from the Tashkent state Institute of medicine in the TashPMI. Academic Lyceum of TashPMI is three years of study, the government resolution and a national curriculum for training based on the education act and consistent national standards. Academic lyceums are an independent legal entity, and the Director of the Lyceum is appointed by the Republican Commission on a competitive basis and appointed by the center of secondary special education under the Ministry of higher and secondary special education.

VI. The governance of higher education institutions

37. TashPMI management is carried out in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan and in accordance with this Charter in accordance with the principle of coordination of public administration through the academic Council.

38. Direct control of TashPMI is exercised by the rector appointed by the order of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated March 9, 1992 № 137.

The rector shall be fully responsible for the activities of the higher educational institution, as well as for the internal regulations of the higher educational institution, the Regulations on higher education and the obligations set forth in this Charter. The President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, in accordance with the laws of higher education institutions, working on behalf of all ministries, departments, enterprises, higher education institutions to participate as a representative of the property lawyer, agreement, responsibility, banking institutions of higher education to open accounts in financial resources, provides instructions for use in a given order. The competence of the rector of the University included:

- issuing orders that are binding on all employees, students and other interns of higher education institutions;
- appoint and dismiss deans and chief accountant of the faculty in consultation with the Ministry of government of the Republic of Uzbekistan;
- represents candidates for the position of Vice-rectors, determines Deputy rectors, deans and their duties;
- hiring and dismissal of employees and employees of higher educational institutions, as well as scientific and pedagogical personnel in accordance with the labor legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan and the Cabinet of Ministers;

- defines the tasks of research, experimental and other organizations and departments that are part of the higher educational institution, and approves the regulations on them;

- defines monthly subsidies and additions to the salaries of employees of higher educational institutions;

- approves internal procedures by agreeing with the trade Union Committee or other competent body of the higher educational institution;

- cancel orders of higher education institutions issued in violation of applicable laws or regulations of the Ministry;

- funds allocated in accordance with the standard units of the higher state educational institutions and approved by the payroll Fund, higher education institutions, the number of employees and salary scales of the higher educational institution of higher education professors and teachers and the salaries of staff will confirm the unity of the state and the provisions of the descriptions;

- on the recommendation of the academic Council of the higher educational institution confirms the decision to open or close faculties, chairmen in accordance with the relevant legal acts. Depending on the requirements of the "Regulations on the Department of higher education" formed or canceled on the recommendation of the academic Council of higher education. The rector of the higher educational institution is not allowed to work in a double profession (except for scientific and methodological instructions) in a paid University or other higher educational institution. The rector is unable to perform his functions with the substitution.

39. In accordance with the "Regulations on higher education", a Scientific Council was established to study the main issues of the University in TashPMI. The academic Council consists of the rector and Chairman of the academic Council, Vice-presidents, deans of faculties and heads of departments of training, as well as representatives of the Council of trade unions of students and higher educational institutions. Other members of the academic Council are elected by secret ballot at the General meeting (conference). The number of professors and teachers elected to the academic Council is determined by the order of the rector. The competence of the academic Council, the order of its election and activity is determined by the "Regulations on the scientific Council of the University", approved by the authorized state body for education management.

40. TashPMI has created a public body for the management of higher education and consists of representatives of the fundamental ministries, local authorities, business circles, public organizations, savings and Trustees and other educational institutions. The composition, powers, structure and activities of the Board of Trustees are determined by the "regulations on the boards of guardianship".

41. In TashPMI there are trade unions and other public organizations. The protection of the interests of students and staff is carried out by trade unions and educational institutions elected by the higher educational institution. The rights of students and employees and the management of higher education institutions are as

follows: social protection of students and staff, labor protection, spiritual and educational, social activities, financial assistance to low-income and large workers. In accordance with the current rules TashPMI may include scientific and voluntary society, scientific and methodological councils, scientific and technical councils and commissions, the Council of young scientists and others. Rector and academic Council in their work control the recommendations of public organizations in higher education and take them into account in their work.

42. The faculties of TashPMI are coordinated by the Dean appointed by the rector with the approval of the Ministry of health. Dean of the faculty his work is in the "regulations on the faculty of higher educational institutions". In accordance with the "regulations on the faculty of higher education" at the faculty can be created scientific Council. The structure, powers, procedure and procedure of the academic Council are determined by the "regulations on the academic Council of the faculty of higher education". The Chairman of the Academic Council of the higher educational institution is appointed on the basis of competitive selection in accordance with the Charter approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan. The powers of the head of the Department and the order of the Department are determined by the "regulations on the Department of higher education".

VII. Financial and economic activities and material and technical base.

43. In order to carry out the activities provided for by this Charter, the state shall place premises, structures, property complexes, equipment in accordance with the passport of the higher educational institution, as well as property necessary for consumption, social, cultural and other purposes, TashPMI included in the list of officially privatized objects, which are implemented by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan. The land plots allocated by TashPMI are provided to higher educational institutions free of charge.

44. TashPMI provides individuals and legal entities with money, gifts, intellectual and creative products that are the result of the activities of higher education institutions, as well as income from their own activities and property acquired from their own income, ownership.

45. TashPMI has the right to lease the property and act as a lessor. In accordance with the civil code of the Republic of Uzbekistan and the regulations on leasing of state property approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the provision of attached rental of buildings, structures and their parts, equipment and vehicles to a higher educational institution rents other property without the right to dispose of other property with the consent of the scientific Council. The funds received as rent will be used to support and develop the educational process.

46. Financial support of educational activities of TashPMI is financed from the budget funds allocated for the training of specialists on the basis of state grants, funds intended for training and retraining, as well as extra-budgetary funds, including payments for students and interns, contractual funds.

47. The main activity of the higher educational institution TashPMI is the provision of paid services in the educational and other areas that are not harmful. Entrepreneurial activity carried out by a higher education institution must comply with its statutory objectives. The higher education institution has the right to independently dispose of profits after participation in the authorized capital of economic societies and partnerships, to set prices for paid educational services, consultations and other services and other mandatory payments provided for by law. Paid educational services in a higher education institution cannot be distributed or replaced by educational activities through budgetary allocations. Higher education institution independently solves the issues related to the conclusion of contracts, obligations and other conditions that do not contradict the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan and this Charter.

48. In TashPMI the salary is established according to " Regulations on remuneration of employees of higher educational institutions " and according to the uniform tariff scale. The salary of employees is paid to a higher educational institution for the performance of their functional duties and for the work provided for by the employment contract. The amount of additional salary, bonuses and other incentives is determined by the higher education institution in the manner and to the extent provided by law in the framework of the wage Fund. A certain salary may only be revised for the purpose of certification.

49. TashPMI organizes the state institutions created in higher educational institution, allocating rooms for their work and the organization of cleaning. Kitchens and other catering establishments located in the territory of the higher educational institution or on the balance sheet of the higher educational institution, serving students, listeners and staff, are provided with heating, lighting and water supply. Repair, reconstruction or reconstruction of the relevant buildings of the higher educational institution and their financial support are carried out in accordance with the procedure established by law.

VIII. International cooperation

50. TashPMI, in accordance with article 33 Of the law of the Republic of Uzbekistan "on education", participates in international cooperation on education, has the right to establish direct contacts with educational institutions of foreign countries and establish joint educational institutions with them in accordance with the law.

51. Training, retraining and advanced training of foreign citizens of TashPMI, the agreement between the research staff of educational institution in the territory of

the Republic of Uzbekistan interstate educational and research activity of educational institutions of foreign countries, and also foreign citizens of TashPMI and about the agreements signed directly with foreign legal entities.

52. TashPMI has the following rights:

- access to international non-governmental organizations;
- conclusion of cooperation agreements with foreign partners, which cannot be considered as international treaties of the Republic of Uzbekistan;
- organization of structural subdivisions (centers, laboratories, technical palaces and other subdivisions) of higher educational institutions in accordance with the legislation with the participation of foreign partners.

53. TashPMI has the right to engage in foreign economic activity provided by this Charter, in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan, aimed at fulfilling the tasks provided by the law "on education" and the National training program on personnel issues, as well as the development of international relations.

54. foreign Currency proceeds from foreign economic activities, Tashkent pediatric medical institute are used to ensure that their income was legally provided for in its Charter

IX. Final rule

55. TashPMI is responsible for the procedure established by the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan.:

- failure to perform their duties;
- incomplete implementation of educational programs in the educational process in accordance with the curricula and tables;
- life and health of students and employees of higher education institutions during the educational process;
- violation of the rights and freedoms of students and employees of higher education institutions;
- other actions provided by the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

56. TashPMI can be reorganized or liquidated in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan on the basis of the order established by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

57. The University Statute may be developed taking into account the recommendations set forth in this model Statute. The Charter developed by the Higher education institution shall be approved by the relevant ministries and departments and shall be registered and put into effect in accordance with the established procedure. Amendments or additions to the Charter of higher educational institution are provided in accordance with the established procedure.

58. During development of this Charter offers and remarks received from the state Committee of communication and information, Railway management, the state certifying Commission, the state tax Committee, Academy of arts, Navoi mining and

metallurgical combine, the Ministry of health care, the Ministry of agriculture and water management, the Ministry of foreign Affairs were considered.
