I. General rules

1. The Central Asian Medical Pediatric Institute was established in 1972 by decision of the Council of Ministers of July 23, 1971. On the basis of order No. 226 dated March 22, 1988, it was transferred to the Ministry of Health of the Uzbek SSR and renamed as the Tashkent Pediatric Medical Institute (TashPMI)

2. The Tashkent Pediatric Medical Institute (hereinafter referred to as the Institute) is a state higher educational institution and carries out educational activities for the implementation of basic and professional additional educational programs of higher education, and also, in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan, carries out educational and pedagogical and scientific and methodological activities and provides other educational services.

3. In its activities, the Institute is guided by the Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the Law "On Education", the National Training Program, decisions of the Chambers of the Oliy Majlis, Decrees, decisions and orders of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, decisions and orders of the Cabinet of Ministers, relevant regulatory documents of the Ministry of Health of the Republic Uzbekistan, Resolutions and orders of the Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Innovation of the Republic of Uzbekistan, other regulations and this Charter.

4. The Institute is a legal entity of the Republic of Uzbekistan, has an independent balance sheet, settlement, including currency and other accounts in banking institutions. The Institute operates on the basis of full economic accounting, self-financing and covering its own expenses.

5. The Institute has the right to have a round seal depicting the state emblem of the Republic of Uzbekistan, containing its full corporate name in the state language and an indication of location.

6. The Institute has the right to have stamps and forms with its name, its own emblem and, if necessary, other proprietary designations.

7. The Institute has separate property, accounted for on its independent balance sheet, and can, in its own name, own rights, bear obligations, and be a plaintiff and defendant in court.

10. Duration of activity of the Institute is unlimited.

II. THE MAIN TASKS , AIMS , PRINCIPLES AND POWERS OF THE TASHKENT PEDIATRIC MEDICAL INSTITUTE

11. The main tasks of the Institute are:

- satisfaction of the human need for intellectual, cultural and professional development through higher and postgraduate education;
- meeting the needs of society and the state for qualified specialists with higher education;
- the formation of a comprehensively developed and loyal personality, a citizen of an independent state, an ascetic of his Motherland, a person who feels his responsibility to the

people, society and family, respects national and universal values, enriches and strengthens the traditions of the people, conscientiously and honestly working for his benefit;

- promotion of science through research and creative activities of scientific and pedagogical workers and students, the use of the results obtained in the educational process;
- training, retraining and advanced training of highly educated specialists and scientific and pedagogical personnel in the relevant areas of medicine
- preservation and enrichment of the moral, cultural and scientific values of society;
- formation of a high-quality training system for medical specialists that meets international standards;
- dissemination of knowledge among the population, raising its spiritual, educational and cultural level.

As agreed with the Supervisory Board of the Institute:

- taking into account the scientific and pedagogical potential of the institute, the possibilities of its material and technical base, determining the parameters for accepting students on a fee-based contract basis opening new areas of training for bachelors and masters' specialties;
- determination of the cost of education on a paid-contract basis, based on the amount of the full financial support of the institute.

12. The main goals of the institute are:

- meeting the needs of society and the state for qualified medical specialists with higher education;
- improving the quality of training of specialists through the widespread introduction of new information technologies into education and strengthening the integration of the educational process and scientific research;
- creation of conditions for students and workers to realize their mental and creative potential, play sports, and relax;
- to become an innovative university as a unified scientific and educational complex for training highly qualified personnel who can constantly improve themselves and increase intellectual capital;
- integration into the international space and others.

13. The basic principles of activities in the field of education are:

- recognition of the priority of education;
- freedom to choose the form of education;
- inadmissibility of discrimination in the field of education;
- ensuring equal opportunities for education;
- introduction of national and universal values into education and upbringing;
- humanistic, democratic nature of education and upbringing;
- continuity and continuity of education;
- accessibility of education within the limits of state educational standards and state educational requirements;
- unity and differentiation of the approach to the selection of educational programs;
- guarantee of social protection of teachers in society;
- secular nature of the education system;
- encouragement of education, giftedness and talent;
- combination of state and public administration in the education system;
- openness and transparency in the field of educational activities.

14. The main powers of the institute are:

a) in the academic field:

- approval of curricula, training programs, qualified requirements based on professional standards, determination of the language and form of education, taking into account the characteristics of areas of education and specialties;
- determination of the cost of training on a fee-based contract basis, taking into account the requirements in the educational services market;
- establishment and extension of payment terms for paid contracts by students;
- introduction of distance, evening forms of education, as necessary, introduction of a system for assigning dual qualifications, including practical qualifications, in areas of education and specialties;
- implementation of academic mobility with higher educational institutions on the basis of mutual agreements
- determination and implementation of mechanisms for internal control of the quality of education;
- attracting, on a contractual basis, domestic and foreign professors, teachers and specialists capable of applying modern pedagogical technologies in the educational process and conducting scientific research
- establishment, based on market conditions, of wages for highly qualified specialists involved in educational and scientific processes;
- b) in the field of organizational and managerial independence:
 - creation of structural divisions, commercial and non-profit organizations, the main activity of which is related to education, science, implementation and commercialization of their results, not financed from the state budget;
 - determining the procedure for providing paid services in empty buildings and structures;
 - approval of the structure and determination of the number of staff units of the institution, regardless of the standards established for higher educational institutions;
 - opening new and abolishing existing areas of education and specialties based on demand in the labor market;
 - admission to study of citizens of foreign countries on a paid contract basis and the organization of a distance form of their education;
 - other powers in accordance with the current legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

III. STATUS, RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF STUDENTS, TEACHING STAFF AND ADMINISTRATIVE PERSONNEL.

15. Participants in the educational process are: students, parents or other legal representatives of students, teaching staff and administrative and managerial staff.

16. Rights and responsibilities of students.

Students have the right to:

- obtaining higher education on a state or paid contract basis;
- freedom to choose forms of education;
- obtaining a quality education that meets state educational standards, state educational requirements and curricula;
- obtaining the necessary conditions for learning, created taking into account their psychological characteristics and physiological development,

participation in the formation of the content of the education they receive, developed in accordance with the requirements of state educational standards of higher education, in accordance with the procedure established by the state educational institution;

-protection of life and health from any physical and psychological violence, personal insults by teaching staff and other participants in the educational process;

- holidays for recreation and other social needs during the period of education;

-obtaining academic leaves and scholarships, reinstatement of studies and transfer to other educational organizations, from one form of study, profession, field of education, specialty to another;

-participation in the discussion of issues related to the management of the institute;

-free use of the services of educational, methodological, scientific-production, cultural, sports and everyday facilities of the institute in the process of obtaining education;

- participation in research, development, scientific and technical, experimental and innovative activities of the institute.

Students may have other rights in accordance with the law.

It is prohibited at the institute to involve students in work unrelated to obtaining an education.

17. Students are required to:

-master knowledge, skills and abilities based on curriculum, attend classes, independently prepare for them, carry out tasks of teaching staff;

-not to exert physical and (or) psychological violence towards other participants in the educational process and not to interfere with their performance of their duties;

-comply with the requirements of the charter and (or) other constituent documents, the internal regulations of the institute, the rules of places of temporary residence and the requirements of other internal documents on the organization and implementation of educational activities;

-strive for moral, spiritual and physical development and expansion of their worldview;

-respect the honor, dignity and business reputation of other students and teaching staff;

-protect the property, material and cultural values of the institute;

Students may also bear other responsibilities in accordance with the law.

18. Parents and other legal representatives of students under the age of majority are responsible for the education, upbringing, physical, spiritual and intellectual development of the child.

Parents and other legal representatives of students under the age of majority have the right to:

-providing the opportunity to receive education in the family for children with physical, mental, sensory (sensory) or mental disorders, as well as those in need of long-term treatment;

-making a decision on the continuation of education of a child receiving education in a family at an institute at any stage of education, taking into account his opinion;

-making proposals for cooperation with the institute, improving the educational process, developing the material and technical base, and providing charitable assistance to the institute;

-familiarization with the charter and (or) other constituent document of the institute, license, certificate of state accreditation, state educational standards, state educational requirements, qualification requirements, curricula and training programs;

-familiarization with the content of education, the methods of teaching and upbringing used, educational technologies, as well as the results of mastering the educational subjects of their children;

- protection of the rights and legitimate interests of students;

-participation in the discussion of issues related to the management of the institute.

Parents and other legal representatives of students under the age of majority may have other rights in accordance with the law.

Parents and other legal representatives of students under the age of majority are obliged to:

- raise your children in the spirit of humanism, patriotism, hard work, respect for spiritual, national and universal values;
- create conditions for the intellectual, spiritual and physical development of their children;
- comply with the internal regulations of the institute regulating the educational process;
- protect the rights and legitimate interests of their children in the field of education in relations with individuals and legal entities, including in court, without special powers;
- respect the honor and dignity of participants in the educational process.

Parents and other legal representatives of students under the age of majority may bear other responsibilities in accordance with the law.

Parents and other legal representatives of students under the age of majority may bear other responsibilities in accordance with the law.

19. Teaching staff are obliged to:

- respect the honor, dignity and business reputation of participants in the educational process;
 - conduct quality training sessions;
 - use information and communication technologies, advanced and innovative forms and methods of training and education;
 - take into account psychological and individual characteristics, physical and mental health, physiological development of students,
- comply with the requirements of the charter and (or) other constituent documents, the internal labor regulations of the institute;
- systematically improve your qualifications and, if necessary, undergo periodic certification for suitability for the position held.

Teaching staff may also bear other responsibilities in accordance with the law, as well as the agreement concluded between the teacher and the institute.

When carrying out teaching activities, teaching staff are prohibited from committing actions that contradict the norms of morality and ethics.

20. The status of teaching staff is recognized by society and the state. Teaching staff are provided with social support, organizational and legal conditions are created for carrying out professional activities, increasing their social status and authority, and guarantees are provided for them to exercise their rights and legitimate interests.

The rights, honor, dignity and business reputation of teaching staff are protected by the state.

Interference in the professional activities of teaching staff, influencing the correct and objective assessment of students' knowledge, as well as preventing them from performing their official duties are not allowed.

Teaching staff have the right:

- to protect your honor, dignity and business reputation;
- for the development and implementation of proprietary programs within the curriculum, the development of teaching methods, as well as the use of relevant academic disciplines, courses, modules, and the manifestation of creative activity;
- to freedom of choice and use of modern pedagogical forms, means, methods of teaching and education;
 - to demand the creation of the necessary conditions for them to carry out professional activities;

- to use the services of information and resource centers for educational, scientific and methodological areas for free;
- to take part in the development of state educational standards, state educational requirements, qualification requirements, curricula and training programs;
- to carry out scientific, research and creative activities, participate in experimental activities, develop and implement innovations;
- to take part in the discussion of issues related to the activities of the institute;
- to be representatives of workers, join trade unions and non-governmental non-profit organizations, participate in the activities of other civil society institutions;
- to unite in public associations of teaching staff to represent and protect their professional rights and common interests;
- to protect from interference in their professional activities;
- to have free medical examination at public health institutions;
- to participate in protecting the rights and legitimate interests of students.

Teaching staff may have other rights in accordance with the law.

It is prohibited to involve teaching staff in any other work not related to their official duties.

21. The teaching staff includes the positions of head of the department, professor, associate professor, senior teacher, teacher, assistant and trainee teacher.

22. Persons applying for positions in the teaching staff are admitted to the position on a competitive basis.

23. The rights and obligations of administrative, economic, engineering, technical and other service employees of the institute are determined by the internal regulations and job descriptions of the higher educational institution.

IV. PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION AND STUDY AT THE INSTITUTE

24. Admission to study at TashPMI for all applicants is carried out on the basis of the principle of ensuring equal opportunities for education, with the exception of certain categories of persons who, in accordance with the law, may be provided with benefits.

The Institute is obliged to familiarize applicants and (or) their parents or other legal representatives with the charter, license or certificate of state accreditation of the curriculum and other documents regulating educational activities, the rights and responsibilities of students.

Admission to study at the TashPMI institution is carried out on the basis of a state grant and (or) a paid contract.

The procedure for admission to study at TashPMI is established by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Admission of foreign citizens is carried out on the basis of a paid contract (except in cases of allocation of a state grant).

The parameters for admission to higher educational institutions on the basis of a state grant are established by the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

When admitting students to higher educational institutions for preferential admissions, additional admission parameters are established.

25. Targeted admission to study is carried out within the parameters established for the admission of students based on the needs of the relevant territories, spheres and industries in personnel.

Targeted admission to study is carried out on the basis of agreements concluded between personnel customers, the institute and citizens.

Citizens are admitted to the institute through targeted admission to study on a general basis, in accordance with the results of a competitive selection.

26. A student of TashPMI is a person accepted for training by order of the rector of the institute. The student is issued a student card and a rating book.

Admission of students to TashPMI is carried out on the basis of applications from persons with general secondary, secondary specialized, vocational education in accordance with the procedure established by the law and the rules for admitting students to higher educational institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan .It is carried out by the State Commission on the basis of points scored based on the results of tests according to the rating system.

27. Students receiving education on the basis of state grants and on the basis of a paid-contract form of education in isolation from working activities are provided with a scholarship in the manner and amount determined by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Undergraduate and graduate students have the right, on the basis of relevant legal documents, to receive the State Scholarship of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan and the State Scholarships named after Ibn Sina, Islam Karimov, as well as those appointed by other public organizations, legal entities and individuals aimed at education.

28. During the period of military service, restoration of health, pregnancy and childbirth, as well as parental leave, the student may be granted academic leave in the manner approved by the Ministry of Higher and Secondary Specialized Education of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

29. In accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan, full-time students are allowed to defer military service while studying at a higher educational institution.

30. Students who need a student hostel of the Institute are provided with a room that meets sanitary standards and rules in the students hostel of TashPMI. In students dormitories, utility bills are determined by the higher education institution.

Students are allowed to work at the institute itself, as well as in other places in their free time from study in the manner prescribed by the current regulatory documents of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

31. A student expelled from the institute voluntarily or for valid reasons has the right to return to studies on the basis of the procedure and rules for the transfer, restoration and expulsion of students.

The reinstatement of persons previously expelled from higher educational institutions at the initiative of the administration into the ranks of students in all forms of education is carried out on the basis of a paid contract.

The Institute has the right to transfer (repeatedly) undergraduate and graduate students to other higher educational institutions on the basis of established procedures and rules.

32. Students of non-state higher educational institutions and branches of higher educational institutions of other countries (centers, departments, consulting points, etc.) who do not have a license to conduct educational activities on the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan cannot be transferred to TashPMI.

The transfer, restoration and expulsion of students from one higher educational institution to another is carried out by the current legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan

33. Disciplinary measures against students are applied in accordance with local acts of TashPMI and the current legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

34. TashPMI organizes advanced training courses for medical personnel and their retraining in accordance with current regulatory documents.

Listeners are considered to be persons studying at the faculty of training and retraining of doctors at the institute. The status of listeners in the field of services in the field of education is equated to the status of students and masters studying in the corresponding form of education.

35. Doctoral studies, basic doctoral studies or independent training are considered as a type of continuous education at Tashkent PMI, aimed at meeting the needs of society for highly qualified scientific and scientific-pedagogical personnel by persons conducting scientific research in all specialties of medicine and preparing a dissertation for obtaining a corresponding academic degree.

Postgraduate education is carried out in the following forms:

basic doctoral studies;

doctoral studies;

independent research.

Basic doctoral studies - financed from the state budget of the Republic of Uzbekistan, in-depth study of the specialty and preparation of a doctoral dissertation without the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in isolation from work, a form of postgraduate education of scientific and scientific-pedagogical personnel of the highest qualification, organized at the institute for the purpose of in-depth study of the specialty and training and defending their doctoral dissertation for the purpose of conducting scientific research.

Doctoral studies - financed from the state budget of the Republic of Uzbekistan, in-depth study of the specialty and preparation of a doctoral dissertation in isolation from production, a form after higher education of scientific and scientific-pedagogical personnel of the highest qualification, organized at the institute for the purpose of in-depth study of the specialty and the preparation and defense of their doctoral dissertation (DSc) for the purpose of scientific research.

Independent research - a form of education after higher education on the job for the preparation of highly qualified scientific and scientific-pedagogical personnel in order to prepare and defend a doctoral dissertation for applicants for the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) or Doctor of Science (DSc) organized by the Institute

36. Education in higher educational institutions lasts up to three years and operates in accordance with current legislation.

IV. Educational and scientific-methodical work

37. The Institute implements the main educational programs of higher and postgraduate education, additional education (retraining and advanced training of personnel) in the following areas and specialties:

1) Higher education (undergraduate and graduate):

a) a form of education separated from working activities (bachelor's degree).

Postgraduate education: research assistant, basic doctoral studies, doctoral studies or independent research, retraining and advanced training.

* new master's specialties can be opened in accordance with the needs, areas of research in medicine, the development of innovative technologies.

38. The Institute implements the main educational programs of training at two levels: undergraduate and graduate.

Bachelor's degree is a basic higher education degree that provides fundamental and practical knowledge in the field of education and lasts 6 years.

Graduates who have completed a bachelor's program are awarded a bachelor's degree based on the results of state certification in the field of education and a state diploma is issued.

Master's degree is a higher education degree based on a bachelor's degree, which provides fundamental and practical knowledge in a particular specialty, and the duration of training is at least 2 years.

Graduates who complete the master's program are awarded a master's degree in a specific specialty, prepared on the basis of the results of state certification, and a state diploma is awarded.

Bachelor's and master's diplomas of state standard give their holders the right to engage in professional activities or continue their education at the next levels of educational institutions.

Primary education in the basic education program is not considered a second higher education.

a) Clinical residency - a type of training that is a part of the retraining system based on the principle of individual training in order to deepen professional knowledge and improve practical skills, master advanced medical technologies.

Training in clinical residency is regulated by the Regulation in App 2 to the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers No. 319 of December 18, 2009.

The training of doctors in clinical residency at the institute is carried out according to the nomenclature of medical specialties approved by the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Uzbekistan, in accordance with the curriculum and curriculum for each specialty, which is compiled on the basis of special requirements for a specialist.

Currently, TashPMI is training doctors in clinical residency in the following specialties:

The Institute provides an opportunity to receive training in joint programs with the St. Petersburg State Pediatric Medical University in 23 specialties of clinical residency. Students of 50% of the training period receive education at TashPMI, and the remaining 50% - at the St. Petersburg State Pediatric Medical University.

39. The organization of the educational process at the institute is regulated by the curricula and programs of subjects developed by the basic higher education institution in the prescribed manner and approved by the rector of the higher educational institution (vice rector for academic affairs) annual calendar plans and class schedules.

Through the educational process, that is, the choice of educational forms, methods and means, it is necessary to create conditions for the assimilation by university students of the main professional educational programs of education.

The unity of the educational process is ensured by state educational standards. The vice-rector for spiritual and moral education is responsible for the management and coordination of the activities of the departments of socio-economic and humanitarian sciences, spiritual, educational and sports departments, students and other public organizations of a higher educational institution.

40. The institute defines the following main types of training: lecture, consultation, seminar, work experience, laboratory work, supervised work, independent work, written work, practice, course project (course work) and master's work.

For all types of classroom studies, an academic hour is set for 45 minutes (or a combined 40-minute lecture without a break). A break between classes of at least 10 minutes, a lunch break of 40 minutes.

Languages of instruction and education: Uzbek, Russian and English.

41. Personnel training at the institute is carried out separately from production.

Within the framework of the program of basic higher professional education, for all forms of education, the state educational standard is used, developed in the prescribed manner and registered with the state agency "Uzstandard".

42. In TashPMI, the academic year is divided into two semesters, and in each of them, students are taught in the form of rating and evaluation control. The transfer of successful students from one course to another is carried out by order of the rector on the recommendation of the dean of the faculty. Students cannot be conditionally transferred from course to course.

The assimilation of educational programs of higher education is regulated in accordance with the "Regulations on the rating system for monitoring and evaluating knowledge of students in higher educational institutions", approved and passed state registration with the Ministry of Higher and Secondary Specialized Education. According to the regulation "Final state certification of graduates of higher educational institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan" will be completed with final certification.

The institute carries out scientific and methodological work aimed at improving the quality of training of specialists through the use of advanced pedagogical and information technologies, means of individualization of education and self-study, a modular system and distance learning.

Department of Information Analysis and Statistics, Departments One and Two, Anti-Corruption Department "Compliance Control", Department of Organizing Research Activities for Gifted Students, Student Registration Sector, Student Employment Department (Career Center), Advanced Technologies and Center for Strategic Initiatives, Students hostels 1, and 2, Sports and Recreation Complex, Coordinating Department for Providing Students with Housing, Information Resource Center, Editorial and Publishing Department, Editorial Board of "Pediatrician" Journal, "Pediatrician" Newspaper, Research Laboratory, Human Resources Department, Internal Audit and Financial Control Service, Legal Counsel, Clinical (training) bases and department of student practice, Clinic of TashPMI, Clinical bases of TashPMI, Technical and operational and economic department, Department of civil labor protection, Office and archive, Planning and financial department, Accounting department, Sports camp, Psychologist, Secretaries, Boiler room, Garage.

The Academic Lyceum operates under the Tashkent Pediatric Medical Institute in accordance with the established procedure.

Public organizations:

Committee of the Trade Union of Employees and Students, Youth Union "Union of Youth of Uzbekistan", Advisor to the Rector for Women's Affairs, Curatorial Council, etc.

Changes and additions can be entered the structure of the institute in the manner established by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the Ministry of Health, the Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Innovation of the Republic of Uzbekistan, as well as the Supervisory Board of the Tashkent Pediatric Medical Institute.

VI. Management of higher educational institution

45. The Supervisory Board is a public body that manages the institute, does not have the status of a legal entity, and is composed of representatives of the founding ministries, personnel customers, representatives of the public and the institute and other persons. The composition, powers, procedure for the formation and activities of the Supervisory Board are determined by the Regulations "About the Supervisory Board."

The Supervisory Board has the following powers:

- business plan of the institution for the financial year (which shows the main indicators of the institution's activities, including goals, planned results and analysis of the organization of the personnel training system in the institution), as well as approval of income and expenditure parameters and discussion of their implementation.
- making a decision on determining the parameters of admission to study on a paid contract basis in areas, specialties and specialization of education;
- studying the activities and listening to information from rectors and vice-rectors on the implementation of the tasks assigned to the institute;
- assignment to the internal audit service to carry out additional financial control;
- development of the institute and resolution of issues related to its financial activities;
- assessment of the manager's performance

The supervisory board of the institute may have other rights in accordance with current legislation.

46. The direct management of TashPMI is carried out by the rector, who is appointed and dismissed by the Supervisory Board.

The management of institute is carried out on the basis of coordinating public administration principle through the Institute Council, the Supervisory Board, the sole management in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan and this Charter.

The rector is fully responsible for the activities of university, as well as the internal regulations of the higher education institution, the Regulations on Higher Education and the duties established by this Charter.

In accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the rector acts on behalf of the higher educational institution, participates as its representative in all institutions, enterprises, he is responsible for the property of the higher educational institution, draws up contracts, gives powers of attorney, opens university bank accounts in banking institutions, uses money to carry out statutory tasks, gives instructions to apply them in the prescribed manner.

Powers of the Rector of the Institute:

- gives necessary issues orders and tasks for all employees, students and other learners;
- appoints and dismisses deans of faculties and chief accountants in agreement with the subordinate ministry (department);
- recommends candidates for the positions of vice-rectors of institute and determines individual tasks and duties of vice-rectors, deans;
- recruits and dismisses workers and employees of the institute, as well as scientific and pedagogical staff in the manner prescribed by the labor legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan and the Cabinet of Ministers;
- determines the tasks of research, experimental and other organizations and departments entering the institute staff, and approves the regulations on them;
- determines monthly allowances and additional payments to the employees' salary of the institute;
- in agreement with the trade union committee or other authorized body of the institute, approves the internal regulations, signs collective agreements and treaties;
 - cancels orders issued by the institute in violation of the existing legal documents or regulatory legal documents of the Ministry;
- approves the funds and the payroll fund allocated at the institute in accordance with the Standard staff units, the number and official salaries of employees having approved at university, the teaching staff composition of university and the staff units of employees are within the framework of tariff official salaries; On recommendation of the Council of Institute, the rector approves decisions on opening or closing faculties, departments in accordance with legal documents in the prescribed manner.

Based on the requirements of the "Regulations on the Department of University", the departments are created or liquidated on the recommendation of the Council of the Institute at the University.

47. In accordance with the "Regulations on Higher Education", the Council is being created to resolve the main issues of the institute's activities.

The chairman of the Council of the Institute is rector, the Council includes vice-rectors, deans of faculties and heads of departments for training specialists, as well as representatives of the trade union council of students and employees of the university. The remaining members of the Council are elected by secret balloting at the general meeting (conference). The number of professors and teachers being elected to the Council is determined by the rector's order.

The powers of the Academic Council, the procedure for its election and activities are determined by the "Regulations on the Council of University" and approved by the authorized state body for managing education.

48. Trade unions and other public organizations operate in TashPMI. The protection of interests of students and employees is carried out by trade unions of education, science and their elected bodies in university. The rights of the authorities for students and employees, the obligations of administration for university in relation to them are as follows: social protection of students and employees, labor protection, holding spiritual and educational, mass events, providing financial support to low-income workers with many children.

49. To solve statutory problems, scientific and public societies, scientific-methodological, scientific-technical councils and commissions, councils of young scientists, etc. can be organized at the institute.

50. The faculties of the institute are headed by deans appointed by the rector in agreement with the Ministry of Health.

The deans of the faculty in their activities are guided by the "Regulations on the Faculty of University".

In accordance with the "Regulations on the faculty of university", the Academic Council may be created at the faculty.

The composition, powers, procedure for activities formation of the Academic Council are determined by the "Regulations on the Academic Council of the faculty of university."

51. The activities of department are headed by the head, elected by the Council of the Institute on the basis of the competition in accordance with the Regulations approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

The powers of department head and the procedure for the activities of department are determined by the Regulations "On the Department of University".

VII. FINANCIAL AND ECONOMIC ACTIVITY AND MATERIAL AND TECHNICAL BASE

52. The Institute carries out its activities in accordance with the current legislature Buildings, structures, property complexes, equipment in accordance with the passport of the higher educational institution, as well as property necessary for domestic, socio-cultural and other purposes, are assigned by the state (founder) with the rights of operational management in order to carry out the activities provided for by this Charter.

The Institute is included in the list of facilities subject to withdrawal from state ownership and privatization only by decision of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

The land plots allocated to the institute are assigned to university for free use for indefinite period.

53. The right of ownership to funds, property and other objects of property, the results of intellectual and creative activity, which are the result of the activities of university, as well as income received from its activities, and objects of property acquired at the expense of these incomes, are transferred to the institute as gift, or it is given as bonus or testament.

54. The Institute has the right to operate as a lessor and lessee of property in accordance with the current legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

The funds received as rent are used for the stated purposes of the institute.

The Institute has the right to spend the funds necessary to strengthen the material and technical base, as well as to carry out major and current repairs of its buildings at the expense of its own extra-budgetary funds.

55. The institute is financed from the republican budget of the Republic of Uzbekistan on the basis of an agreement for students studying on the basis of a state grant and training on the basis of a state order, at the expense of personnel customers, as well as extra-budgetary funds and other sources not prohibited by law.

The institute has the right to provide paid educational and other services, as well as engage in business activities in accordance with the statutory objectives.

The provision of paid educational services should not interfere with the main activities of the institute.

The procedure for collecting fees for the provision of additional educational services is established by them independently.

The Institute has the right to independently dispose of funds received by them through the provision of paid educational and other services and engaging in entrepreneurial activities.

Additional sources of funding for the institute are:

- funds received through training, retraining and advanced training of personnel on the basis of agreements, including those concluded with foreign individuals or legal entities;

- funds received from the performance of research, educational, methodological and other work not prohibited by law on the basis of orders from individuals and legal entities;

- income received from the sale of products, performance of work and provision of services by educational organizations;

- funds received from the rental of buildings, structures and equipment;

- funds (interest) received by placing free funds of educational organizations on deposits with banking institutions;

- funds allocated by state and economic management bodies, as well as local government bodies; bank loans and advances;

- charitable funds of individuals and legal entities.

The creation of structural units, commercial and non-commercial organizations is the main direction of activity, which is related to education, science, implementation and commercialization and their results, which are not financed from the state budget.

56. A paid service in the field of education and other areas is possible, which does not harm the core activities of the institute. The economic activity of the institute must comply with the tasks defined in its charter.

The Institute has the right to participate in the statutory fund of business entities, set prices for paid educational services, consultations, independently dispose of the income remaining after paying taxes and other obligatory payments provided by law.

The provision of paid educational services of the institute cannot be carried out within the framework of educational activities at the expense of funds allocated from the budget and instead of it.

The Institute independently resolves issues related to the conclusion of contracts, the definition of obligations and other conditions that do not contradict the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan and this charter.

57. Official salaries at the institute are determined in accordance with the agreement of the Rector of the Institute and the employee when concluding an employment contract (agreement).

An employee of university is paid a salary (rate) for the performance of his functional duties and work stipulated by the employment contract. The amount of additional payment, bonuses and other material incentives is determined by university within the framework of an independent wage fund in the manner and amount prescribed by law.

Established salaries may be revised only in order to increase them based on the results of attestation.

58. The allocated premises necessary for the activities of public organizations are created at the institute.

Premises located on the territory or on the balance sheet of the university and serving students, and employees of the canteen and other catering facilities are rented out with the provision of heating, lighting and water supply.

Repair, reconstruction or construction of the corresponding buildings of the institute, their financial support is carried out in accordance with legislative documents.

VIII. THE INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

59. In accordance with the current legislation the institute has the right to participate in international cooperation on education issues, establish direct links with relevant educational institutions of foreign states, and together with them to open joint university, according to legal documents.

60. The Institute has the following rights:

- entrance to international non-governmental organizations;
- conclusion in the prescribed manner of cooperation agreements with foreign partners that cannot be considered international treaties of the Republic of Uzbekistan;
- organization of structural divisions of a higher educational institution (centers, laboratories, technical departments and other divisions) with the participation of foreign partners in accordance with the law.

61. Training, retraining and advanced training of foreign citizens of institute, teaching and research work of scientific and pedagogical personnel of educational institution outside the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan, are carried out on the basis of contracts concluded directly with foreign legal offices. agreements between the relevant educational authorities of foreign states, as well as foreign citizens in accordance with the legislation of TashPMI

62. In accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan, TashPMI has the right to carry out foreign economic activity aimed at fulfilling the tasks provided for by this Charter and the Law "On Education" and the National Training Program, as well as the development of international relations.

63. The Institute has the right to participate in international cooperation in the field of higher and postgraduate education of the Republic of Uzbekistan in the following order:

By decision of the Council of the Institute, establish direct relations with the relevant educational institutions of foreign states, conclude cooperation agreements with them, create faculties and departments in cooperation in accordance with the law;

participation in the program of bilateral exchange with students, researchers, pedagogical and scientific workers;

holding and participating in scientific conferences, seminars, videoconferences, congresses, symposiums, fairs, meetings and other events dedicated to the development of science and education at the institute;

implementation of fundamental and applied research works on orders of foreign legal entities;
participation in international programs of vocational education and improvement of higher and postgraduate educational institutions;
preparation of state standards and educational programs for bachelors, masters, specialists and scientists that meet foreign standards;
passing qualifying practice on the basis of student exchange programs;
creation of joint master's specialties;
implementation of foreign internships by undergraduates of the institute;
by regularly sending promising young specialists to republican and foreign universities and research centers for master's and doctoral studies, constantly improve the scientific and pedagogical competence of university;
joint management of master's programs, master's theses and training of specialists;
training in advanced training courses and retraining of teaching staff abroad;
development of educational and regulatory documents and the creation of educational and methodological literature in cooperation;
carry out joint research activities, including the implementation of candidate and doctoral dissertations;
publications in specialized journals (collections) of both universities or research centers;

64. Foreign currency and material income of institute from foreign economic activity are used to ensure the activities specified in its Charter in accordance with the law.

IX. INSTITUTE ACTIVITY MONITORING

65. At the end of the reporting period, the institute submits the financial report and other documents, the list of which is indicated in legal documents, to the authorized bodies, and, it is responsible for the safety of documents and their transfer for storage in the prescribed manner.

66. Control over the activities of the institute as an executive body is carried out by the founder and other authorized state bodies in the manner prescribed by the charter.

X. REORGANIZATION AND END OF ACTIVITY

67. Reorganization and liquidation of educational organizations are carried out in the manner established by law.

In case of reorganization of educational organizations, their property is transferred to the newly created educational organization on the basis of legal succession.

When educational organizations are liquidated, the property belonging to them is returned to the founders (participants) after satisfaction of the creditors' claims, unless otherwise provided by law.

XI. OTHER PROVISIONS

68. All changes and additions made to this Charter are subject to approval according to the rules provided for by law, followed by state registration. All changes and additions made to this Charter come into force in the manner prescribed by law.

69. This Charter comes into force from the moment of registration in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

70. If any provision of this Charter becomes invalid, the remaining provisions remain in force.

71. Issues not resolved by this Charter are resolved in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan.
